„Impact of the European Union on Criminal Law of EU Member States“

In order to ensure swift processing of submitted papers and their publications in the Collection of Papers, we would like to ask you to pay attention to these instructions for formatting of papers. These instructions concern the formal part of the elaboration of the paper only.

The content of the paper is subject of peer review, where the reviewers shall evaluate the content of the contribution, arguments presented within the contribution and they shall state whether the paper will be accepted for publication or its publication shall be rejected.

These instructions set exclusively requirements of formal editing of the contribution. The organizing committee reserves right to reject the publication of the paper, which will not fulfill set requirements for formal editing.

Language of paper: *Slovak, Czech, English.*

We ask authors to respect the grammatical and stylistic rules of chosen language as thoroughly as possible. The author shall be responsible for the level of language. The papers will not undergo editorial or stylistic revision.

Deadline for submission of the paper: **30th September 2022**

The paper shall be submitted electronically, by uploading the text file to conference portal. The papers submitted after the deadline shall not be accepted for publication.

File format of the paper: *.doc, .docx*

We ask authors to respect the standard file format of the MS Word text files. We specifically ask authors not to submit their papers in the .pdf files.

Range of the paper: 10-15 pages

Footnote:	<i>Cochin 10b, align into block (no tabs)</i>
Line spacing:	<i>1,15</i>

We would like to ask the authors to avoid using CAPITAL LETTERS if possible.

- We ask you to use the footnotes for references and citations only;
- Abovementioned styles of citations are not exhaustive; the elaboration of the paper requires citation of legal acts, judicial decisions of courts and arbitration bodies, international treaties, decisions of international organizations and other documents;
- In the text of the paper it is acceptable to use the italics to mark the name of the decision of the court, or to mark the title of specific document or source. However, we ask authors to avoid extensive use of **bold letters**, *italics* or underlined words. Besides stating of the name of the author of the cited work, the use of CAPITAL letters is not welcome.

¹ Author shall state the date of last access to the website, where the cited source can be found.
